JEPIC has been conducting bilateral seminar program with electric utilities in ASEAN Countries under strong support from electric power companies in Japan. The purpose of the program is to strengthen their business infrastructure such as technical basis, management method and human resources development.

JEPIC and PLN, the Indonesian electric power corporation, launched their bilateral cooperation program on 1991 by holding the first seminar in Japan. The first visiting seminar in Indonesia was carried out on 1992. After the initiation, JEPIC and PLN have been continuing annual seminar in Japan as well as in Indonesia.
